WHO IS THE COURSE FOR?

This course is for teachers who are teaching another subject, such as geography, history or sciences, but using English to teach the subject. It is perfect for teachers who are looking for strategies and skills to better support students.

COURSE OUTLINE

The course provides teachers with an understanding of the language learning processes, as well as which teaching strategies could be used to support learners and increase student engagement. The course takes a practical approach with discussions and demonstrations of materials.

Topics include developing students' reading and writing skills, exploiting texts for language and evaluating and adapting materials. Participants are asked to bring some teaching materials for their subject to use on the course. As CLIL is implemented differently around the world, it is a great opportunity to compare and contrast different experiences.
